Klaus Graf Quartet

After having played as a sideman along different national and international jazz formations, alto saxophone player Klaus Graf founded his first own quartet in 2001.

The music consists in big parts of the bandleader's compositions, which were written only for the purpose to serve the quartet's concept: jazz with a soul character, melody-based and groove-driven music for body and head.

The musicians of the Klaus Graf Quartet are international recognized jazz soloists and constantly working together with different jazz stars. After a furious premier with outstanding criticisms was, the debut album "Changes in Liv" recorded in January 2002.

In October 2007, the second album "Moving On" with arrangements and self-composed songs was produced.

The Quartet travelled in India on successful concert tours in 2017 and 2020.

The third CD by the Klaus Graf Quartet "Live in India", a live recording of the 2020 India concert tour, was released in March 2021. This includes a suite in 3 movements, the Mysore Suite, dedicated to the city of Mysore in India Karnataka, South India.
